### SaskEnergy spends \$5.7 million to make power from wasted engine heat

REGINA - Saskatchewan's government-owned natural gas company is spending \$5.7 million to make electricity from wasted heat.

SaskEnergy President Doug Kelln says the plan is to use technology to convert waste heat from compressor station engines to usable power.

The first project will be at Rosetown, Sask., and should be ready next month. SaskEnergy Minister Dustin Duncan says the project will recover its costs in seven to 10 years, and the equipment has a lifespan of 40 years.

SaskEnergy is hoping to produce as much energy as it uses by 2015.(CKRM)
